Re "Religious Intolerance, letter to the editor, March 24"

John Clubine asks why the National Post focuses on Islamic religious intolerance, before claiming that Hindus in India and Pakistan have killed Christians, and that Catholic mobs have slain Mexican Protestants in Chiapas.

He should keep in mind that Pakistan is an Islamic state where Hindus have been subject to Muslim genocide and reduced to a tiny minority. Pakistani Christians, in fact, share with Hindus a history of oppression by Muslims.

Readers should also remember that incidences of 'persecution' by Hindus and Christians are far less numerous than those committed by radical Islamists. The media focus on Islamic persecution of minorities simply because radical Islam is the biggest culprit in this area.
